



VCL End of Life (EOL) Announcement

Date – March 15, 2009

VCL - VeriWave Command Library

VeriWave is providing customers with advance notice of the End of Life (EOL) support for VCL, VeriWave's Command Library.

Reason for EOL:

The VCL interface is intended to allow for custom test development using a scripting language and provides a very low level detailed interface.

1. In almost all applications, VCL has been used to automate existing Veriwave tests.
2. The complexity of the 802.11 protocol means that the user must create a significant body of code even for the simplest tasks.

VeriWave has invested significant effort and created significant intellectual property in ensuring its emulated 802.11 clients behave correctly. Similarly, the task of automating existing tests has been addressed by VeriWave's WaveAutomation product. WaveAutomation provides a scripting interface that allows for control and configuration of all important test parameters for all VeriWave test suites. In addition WaveAutomation allows for proper integration for configuring the Device Under Test, and provides access to a database of results that are generated by the tests.

End of Sale:

Effective March 15, 2009, VeriWave will discontinue selling VCL.

Compatibility Issues:

Recommended replacement in most cases is WaveAutomation

Technical Support:

Technical support for VCL will continue through September 15, 2009, at which time all support will be discontinued. In the meantime, technical support will continue to provide programmers reference.
